

**WAVERLY BAND BOOSTERS
GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 14, 2006**

Welcome and Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 8:11 PM. Randy welcomed everyone present and introductions were made.

The Adoption of the Agenda and Meeting Minutes

A motion was made to adopt the agenda and all were in favor. The meeting minutes from September 2006 were reviewed and accepted as written.

Treasurer's Report

Director's Report

David Larzelere reported that the Silver Bells parade is Friday night. The Gordon Food Fundraiser is going well because of the change in dates this year. A generous donation has been made for new band uniforms. The uniforms may be ready for the band banquet in June. The Holiday concert is on December 18th. It will be a collage concert involving the choir, orchestra, and all the bands. The jazz band will be playing at several engagements during December.

David Gorbe reported that the Solo & Ensemble Festival is on Saturday. There are eleven students participating. Grades were better for the end of marking period. The middle school orchestra and concert will be on December 12th.

Other Old Business

The Gordon Foods Fundraiser is in effect right now. Also the Christmas tree and wreath sale will be starting. Forms are available in the newsletter. Jeff Blair is the chair and will inform the workers of their scheduled work time at the lot. No one under 16 years of age is allowed to work the lot without an accompanied adult. Trees start at \$30 - \$40 and wreathes are \$30. The apple pie fundraiser was a success. We sold about 1700 pies. Karen and Jan did a terrific job. The next fundraiser is the Jane's Cookie Dough sale. Orders for cookie dough will be taken in February and delivery is in March.

New Business

Jim and Dave discussed lights for Silver Bells. Dave stated that we need 110 lights. A reminder that the batteries can be recycled at Delta Township was stated. Shirley inquired about the number of attendees at the upcoming concerts so that she can order punch. Volunteers are always welcome to help with refreshments at the concerts.

The Waverly Education Foundation Gala in December is having a centerpiece competition. The Gala is at the Sheraton Hotel and includes a silent auction and dinner. The entertainment includes the jazz band, chamber orchestra, and the Winans Children Choir. The cost is \$50 per person, \$80 per couple, or \$350 for a table of ten.

Jim Annis asked us to send a note of appreciation to the shoe repair store. The mascot's shoes were repaired for a donation of \$60. Luke Slocum is still fundraising for a new mascot uniform.
